MAYORAL PROCLAMATION (by Executive Order of the Mayor)

PROCLAMATION REORGANIZING THE CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES

In order to allow for the formation of essential NEW CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES, while maintaining all the aspects of the former Committees, I am hereby combining the logical functions of some committees, adding additional duties to other Committees and, splitting the City Hall – Finance Committee into two Committees with additional duties assigned to each, to better focus on the needs of both areas.

The following two New City Council Committees are hereby created:

STRATEGIC CITY PLANNING & PHYSICAL ASSET PLANNING (EQUIPMENT – BUILDINGS) Created to direct and oversee the planning goals and activities of all Committees.

CURRENT PROJECT MANAGEMENT – CONSTRUCTION & INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS Created to directly oversee and manage all major construction projects.

A New **CITIZENS INPUT COMMITTEE** has been created by a separate proclamation.

The Reorganized Committee's are hereby Named and Structured as:

FIRE - AMBULANCE

POLICE - EMERGENCY PREPARADNESS - EVACUATION AND ACTION PLANS

WATER - SEWER - DRAINAGE


STREETS - LIGHTS - PARKS - RECREATION

CITY HALL OPERATIONS - ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY - EMPLOYEE POLICY

BUDGET - FINANCE - INVESTMENT - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

LIBRARY & CULTURAL EVENT DEVELOPMENT

All Committees will be made up of three members. Committee Meetings will comply with the Iowa Open Meetings Law as required by The State Code Of Iowa. Committees are allowed ONLY, to discuss and study issues, investigate solutions, work to meet planning goals as directed, and make recommendations to the Full City Council. Any voting will be recorded only as a motion passing or failing, to thus allow Committee Members to freely change their minds, after further thought or discussion with Community Residents, prior to the issues being brought before the Full City Council. The Chairperson of each respective Committee will report orally to the City Council, the activities of their Committee after each Meeting. Committees will strive to meet a minimum of once each quarter with the exception of the Citizen's Input Committee, which will meet as requested, by Citizen Members or Chairperson.

PROCLAMATION CREATING A CITIZEN'S INPUT COMMITTEE

In order to facilitate an easier and more accessible flow of information, regarding concerns and issues of Jesup Citizen's, to the Jesup City Council and Mayor, I hereby create a new Jesup City Council Committee to be known as the:

CITIZEN'S INPUT COMMITTEE

The purpose of this Committee is to allow Citizens, who may not feel comfortable addressing the Jesup City Government directly in a public Meeting, the opportunity to forward their concerns through one of six appointed fellow Citizen Members. Three City Councilpersons will also be named, and make up the remainder of the Committee.

These Citizen Members would then at their discretion, either pass forward these messages to a City Councilperson or the Mayor, or secondly the matter may be brought to the City's attention at a Regular City Council Meeting or Council Committee Meeting directly for discussion.

Additionally, the City may occasionally ask the Citizen's Input Committee, to act as a sounding board for ideas or plans originating from the Jesup City Council. Members are encouraged to feel completely free to make any comments whenever asked for an opinion.


