The Jesup City Council met in a special council meeting on Monday, April 1, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in the Jesup City Hall Council Chambers, 791 6th Street, Jesup, Iowa. Public access to the meeting was accessible through YOUTUBE from a computer, tablet, smartphone, or telephone.

Mayor Chris Even called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Members present: Denny Bell, Chad Kohagen, Andrew Hamilton, and Craig Wright.

Absent: Todd Rohlfen.

Motion by Bell, seconded by Kohagen, to approve the agenda. Motion carried 4:0.

PUBLIC HEARING

Motion by Hamilton, seconded by Wright, to open the public hearing on the matter of the Proposed Property Tax Levy for fiscal year 2024-2025. Motion carried 4:0. The clerk reported a written objection has been filed from Eric and Debbie Frey. Mayor Even read the objection to the council. Mayor Even opened the floor for any objections. The clerk reported that the tax levy for the city portion of the Proposed Property Tax went from \$14.42305 in fiscal year 2023-2024 to \$14.36791 in fiscal year 2024-2025. Hearing no more comments, the Mayor requested a motion to close the public hearing. Motion by Kohagen, seconded by Wright, to close the public hearing. Motion carried 4:0. The Mayor declared the public hearing closed.

Motion by Hamilton, seconded by Kohagen, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 4:0. The meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
