JUNE 18, 2020

Jesup City Council met in a special council meeting on Thursday, June 18, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. in the Jesup City Hall Community Room, 791 6th Street, Jesup, Iowa.

Mayor Chris Even called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

Members present: Denny Bell, David Bishop, Curtis Schares, Craig Wright and Todd Rohlfesen.

Absent: None

Motion by Rohlfesen, seconded by Schares, to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5:0.

Alex Potter, McClure Engineering addressed the council regarding the Wastewater Treatment Plant project. Potter stated that significant improvements to the existing aerated lagoon treatment system are required by the Department of Natural Resources. These improvements include the complete ammonia removal, E. coli bacterial removal and an Iowa Nutrient Reduction Strategy plan for total nitrogen and total phosphorous removal. This project needs to be completed by October 1, 2023. McClure Engineering presented four alternatives to upgrade the existing lagoons. Potter discussed financing alternatives with the council to fund this project and potential sewer rate increases. Potter discussed the remaining schedule for the project with the council. The council would like to tour cities that have implemented these treatment plants. Potter will set up tours.

Motion by Rohlfesen, seconded by Bell, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 5:0. Meeting adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
